### Product Overview

OTag is a smart tracker device that uses Google's Find Hub service, paired with the "Google Find Hub" app on Android devices, to quickly and securely locate your personal items on Google Maps. All location information remains private, and even Google cannot access it.

#### Before You Start

OTag only supports the "Google Find Hub" app. Please make sure to download and install this app from the "Google Play Store" before use. The device is compatible only with Android devices running Android 9 or higher.

to view its location

To navigate to the location, tap "Get Directions" to open map navigation

### Enable Lost Mode

In the "Google Find Hub" app, select your OTag and tap "Mark as Lost". Add your contact information and you will get a notified if the Find Hub Device network locates it.

#### OTag Location Sharing

In the "Google Find Hub" app, select your OTag, then tap "Share Device"

#### Connect to Another Phone

After complete the reset process, then connect to another Android phone.

#### Battery Replacement

1. Pry open the battery at the "open" position on the back of the product with your fingers, remove it, and replace it with a new CR2032 battery, with the front facing up (text facing up)
2. Carefully close the Item Locator by aligning the top hole on both sides.

3. If there is no sound, please confirm whether the battery is installed correctly.

\*After replacing the battery, you can use it without reconnection.

### Detailed Description

This device complies with Part 15 of FCC regulations. The operation is limited by the following two conditions:

1. This device will not cause harmful interference.
2. This device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause poor operation. Note: The manufacturer is not responsible for any radio or television interference caused by unauthorized modification or alteration of this equipment. Such modifications or changes without the explicit approval of the responsible compliance party may render the user's permission to operate this device invalid. The device has been evaluated to meet general RF exposure requirements and can be used under portable exposure conditions without restrictions. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) radiation exposure declaration power is very low, so there is no need to calculate radio frequency exposure.

Once OTag is paired with a device, it will be locked and cannot be paired with another device.

#### Button and Sound instructions

**Power On:** Press the button once (a beep will sound).

**Power Off:** Press and hold the button for 3 seconds (two short beeps will sound).

### Reset

1. Open the "Google Find Hub" app, select your OTag, tap the Settings button, then tap "Remove from Find Hub" and confirm.
2. When the device is turned on, press five times continuously. At the fifth long press don't release your hand until heard the prompt tone.

Note: Please power on the OTag and remove the device from the "Google Find Hub" app before resetting.

#### Fast Pair Instruction

##### Add Otag

1. Make sure your phone's Bluetooth and network are turned on.
2. Press the button once to turn on OTag (a beep will sound).
3. Bring OTag close to your Android device and wait for the

### Maintenance

It is recommended to wear and maintain according to the following three points:

1. Keep the product clean
2. Keep the product dry
3. Please wear the product correctly

### Safety Instructions

1. Keep away from children and pets to avoid accidental swallowing of small parts.
2. Do not expose the device to water or high humidity for long durations.
3. Use only the recommended CR2032 battery—do not attempt to insert other types.
4. Keep the device away from strong magnetic fields to avoid interference.

4. Tap "Connect", read and accept the prompts to complete the pairing.
5. In the "Google Find Hub" app, select "OTag" to customize the device name and category.

### Manual Set Up Instruction (If you miss the pop-up)

1. Open Settings.
2. To "Google".
3. Click on "All Services"
4. In the "Connected Devices & Sharing" menu, select "Devices".
5. Enable "Scan for Nearby Devices"
6. OTag will appear in the list of available nearby devices.
7. Click on it and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the connection.

#### Find Nearby

In the "Google Find Hub" app, select your **OTAG** and tap "Play Sound" to locate your device. Once found, tap Stop Sound to silence the device.

#### Find Far Away

In the "Google Find Hub" app, select your OTag, tap the device
